WhichWayWagga-Vision 2030 on public exhibition

The draft long term vision for the local community is seeking public comment.

After extensive community engagement, council last night resolved to place the draft community vision, *Which Way Wagga - Vision 2030*, on public exhibition.

“This long term strategic planning document ensures that the community will have an agreed vision to help move the whole community forward,” said Mayor Kerry Pascoe.

“The draft community vision will provide a destination for the community in 2030 and has created a document that informs stakeholder planning, including the elected council, for the next twenty years.

“The draft document includes a community vision statement, community values and future directions that everyone who lives in or visits our community can contribute to.”

Wagga Wagga City Council hosted this project on behalf of the community and conducted widespread community engagement to develop this vision.

“The draft document is a very exciting document, providing a great vision that will bring much benefit to the whole community,” added Mayor Pascoe.

During the exhibition period, Council will undertake further sessions for the community to view and comment on the draft document.
